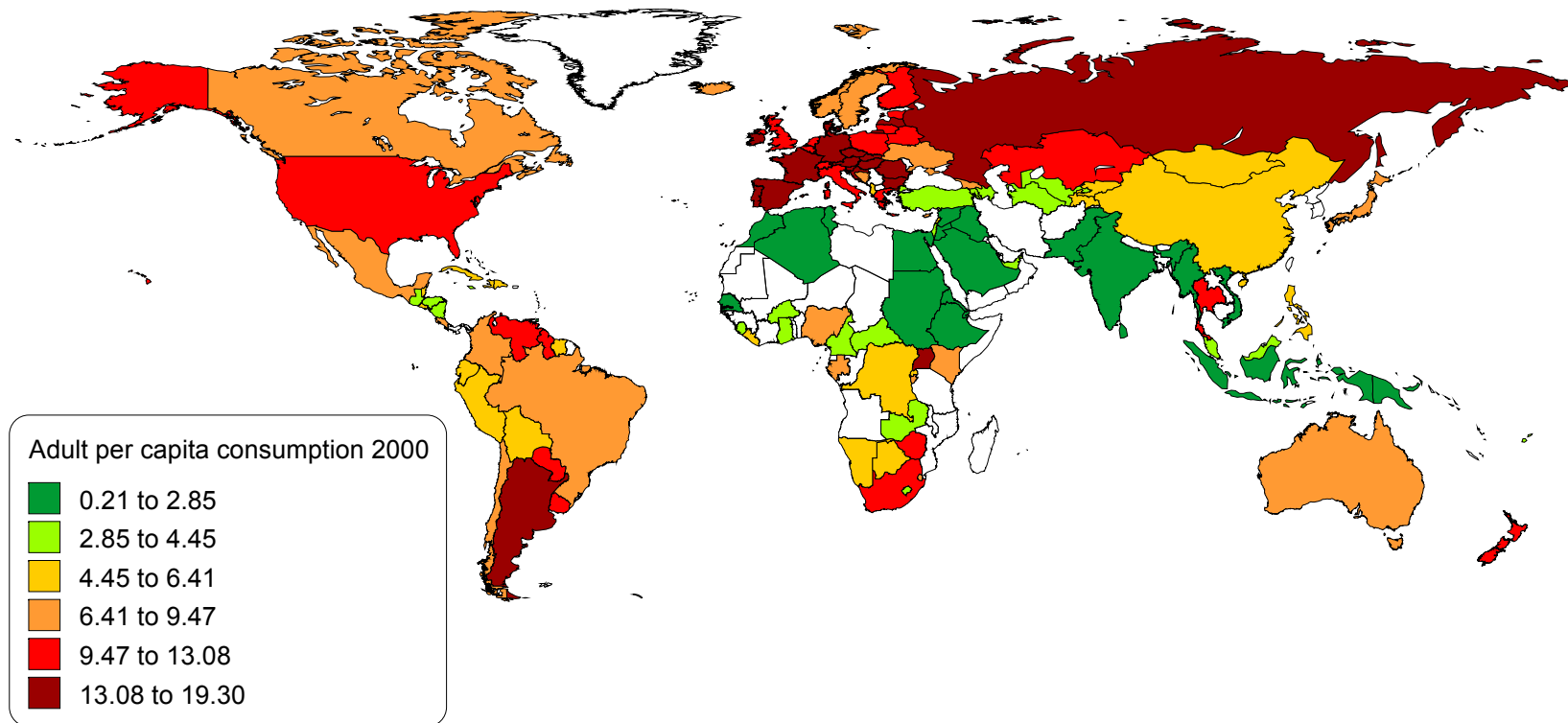

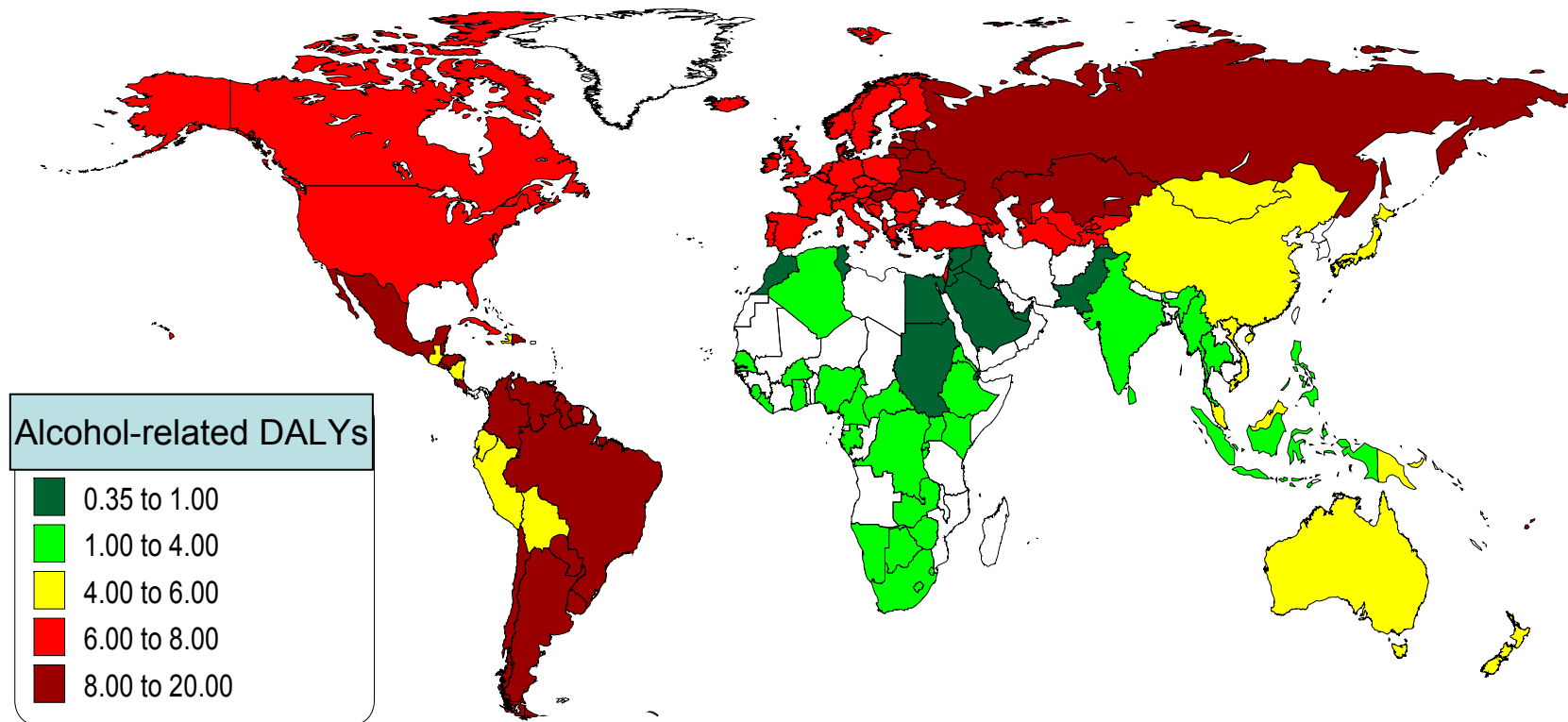

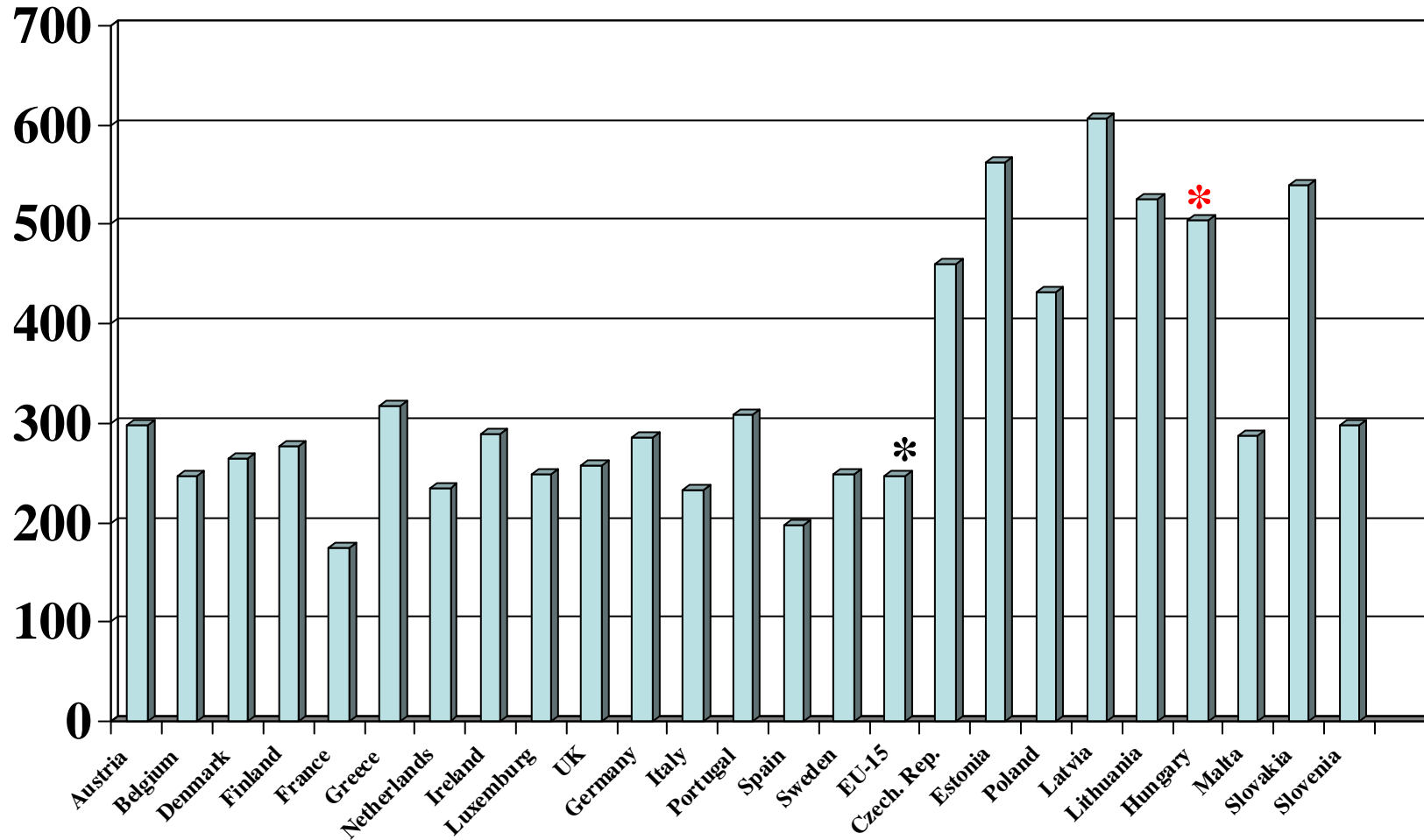
Adult per capita consumption in litre pure alcohol 2000
