

Delegates by Geographic Area





The main objective of the YNP is to invite young nephrologists to different activities of the ERA-EDTA.





ERA-EDTA COMMITTEE FOR INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS (ComIA)

The “ERA-EDTA COMMITTEE FOR INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS” (ComIA) will be in charge of following all the initiatives related to other societies, of proposing new initiatives and updating the Council accordingly.

ERA-EDTA is therefore entering a new exciting era beyond its traditional role in Europe and the Mediterranean adjacent countries, confirming the position of Europe as one of the leaders of nephrology around the world as follows:

- 1) ERA-EDTA is willing to participate in the **annual meeting of other societies** to present **highlights of the annual ERA-EDTA meeting**.
- 2) ERA-EDTA is willing to **co-sponsor CME courses or other educational/scientific events** with other societies that would otherwise not be able to benefit from the current ERA-EDTA CME program.
- 3) ERA-EDTA is willing to **yearly sponsor short term and long term clinical fellowships for young investigators and clinicians** living in developing countries who, according to the current ERA-EDTA Fellowship regulations, would otherwise not be able to participate in the regular ERA-EDTA Fellowship program. All fellowships however must be performed in Europe, or bordering countries, and at the end of the training the fellow must return to his/her country of origin.

The next deadline to apply for ComIA Clinical Fellowships will be **September 30, 2013**. Please check your inbox or this website for the launching of a second call 2013.
